SAFEGUARDING and HEALTH AND SAFETY NOTICES FOR SUMMER TERM 2023

At the end of the school day parents and carers collecting children from Nursery and Reception please wait on Sheraton Road until a member of staff asks you to come up the school drive to collect your child.

Early Years parents and carers- we have a password system in place when collecting children. Please ensure if you are sending another adult to collect your child that they know your child's password.

Parents and carers should not use mobile phones on school premises without prior permission from a School Leader. This includes when bringing and collecting children at the start and end of the school day.

All children who attend Breakfast Club in both departments MUST enter school on a morning via Entrance B as staff cars still enter school grounds up to 8.30am at Entrance C. Parents and carers can walk out of school using Entrance C if you choose to do so, but we kindly remind you for the safety of all children that they use Entrance B as some children do walk this short distance independently.

Any photographs taken at school events are for personal use and MUST NOT be uploaded to any social media accounts if they include other children.

Due to conflict between children PRIME BOTTLES and PRIME DRINKS are not allowed for packed lunches. If your child brings a packed lunch please ensure there are no nut products as we do have children with allergies. We encourage children to bring plain water or flavoured water to drink throughout the day and with packed lunches.

Please ensure your child wears suitable black shoes for school at all times.

When it is your child's PE day please send them into school wearing PE kit. This includes white t shirt, PE shorts or plain black/grey leggings/tracksuit bottoms.

We have seen an increase in children wearing jewellery. In keeping with our school policy only small studded earrings can be worn.

It is best if earrings can be removed at home for PE, swimming and active after school club events. Staff cannot remove ear rings.
