Absences

Children arriving late- all classes

All children arriving late on a morning must enter school via the Main Office (Entrance A). This is vital for <u>SAFEGUARDING REASONS</u> so all class registers are up to date. Children should arrive at school within five minutes from their start time to ensure they are not late.
